Tell us about your company.

Nexo Luce is a high end manufacturer of lighting fixtures and mainly specialises in ready-made and custom-made solutions. The company offers a complete range of lighting fixtures for indoor decorative and technical applications, and outdoor architectural, landscape, and urban use. These are manufactured and assembled at the Nexo Luce factory in Cavriana, Italy.

What trends are you seeing in lighting design and architecture at the moment?

Lighting design trends for the year ahead will continue to seek simplicity in lines and shapes, in order to complement the interior with subtle elegance and refinement.

Materials such as brass, bronze, and copper will likely be used in their rough state, contributing to the overall 'earthy' interior design trends that continue to grow in popularity globally.

Used in multiple forms, blown or moulded, glass is also not to be forgotten. In the future, we will see more glass and metal combinations, creating striking and bold contrasts, while balancing and highlighting the distinct characteristics of each material.

What projects have you been involved in?

Nexo Luce has a track record of delivering custom-made, large chandeliers, and turnkey projects such as five-star hotels, residential and commercial multiplexes, and landscape projects throughout Europe and the Middle East.

What challenges did these projects present?

One of the most challenging projects was the manufacturing and installation of the lobby chandelier located in one of the Centara hotels. The chandelier was composed of six suspended ellipses, made of aluminium and finished in mirrored gold and crystal glass. It had a wingspan of 15m and weighed one tonne. Another challenge was the delivery of an 18m-high chandelier for the Grand Millennium Hotel in Business Bay, Dubai.













What are some of your company's bestselling products and what products have you launched recently?

The company specialises in full turnkey solutions for high-end buildings and projects such as hotels, residential developments, malls, and so on. Nexo Luce has recently launched a new, decorative collection called Oxen. The collection

features contemporary, elegant design and uses materials such as blown glass, brass, and steel. It is inspired by the Bauhaus school of design and the eclecticism of the 1950s and 1960s, centring on clean, geometric forms; balanced visual composition; and the colour scheme of copper, antique bronze, satin gold, and minimalist black and white.
